# RECRUITMENT RULES

#### NOTIFICATION-II

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with Notification No. 5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group B posts of Assistant Engineer (Automobile)/Regional Transport Officer in the Government Automobile Workshop and Transport Department, Pondicherry, namely—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Government Automobile Workshop and Transport Department Group 'B' Post at Assistant Engineer (Automobile) and Regional Transport Officer Recrustment Rules, 1990
  - (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette
- 2 Application These rules shall apply for recruitment to the post specified of column I of the Schedule annexed hereto.
- 3. Number of posts, their classification and scale of pay.— The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4
- 4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.— The method of recruitment in the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.
  - 5. Disqualifications.-No person.-
    - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse fiving or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax.—Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, telax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons
- 7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age hour and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

(i) A Degree in Mochanical/Automebile Engineering of Diploma in Automobile Engineering from a recognised. University/Institution of cavivalent.

(ii) 3/7 years' experience for Doutse Distance holders respectively in work connected with Automobile Mechanical Engineering.

Note 1. Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding expensions is are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the approon that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
