## **CIRCULAR**

Sub: TD – All types of trailers and semitrailers covered under rule 125D,

shall be registered independently -Communicated - Reg.

Ref: G.O No. G.S.R. 1482(E) dt. 7-12-2017 of the Ministry of Road

Transport & Highways, New Delhi.

With reference to the subject cited above, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 64 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

- 2. In this connection it is stated that in the Central Motor Rules, 1989, in rule 47,namely:-
- 1. In sub-rule 3, for figure and words "(3) The modular hydraulic trailers registered under these rules", the figure and words "(4) The modular hydraulic trailers registered under these rules", shall be substituted.
  - 2. After sub-rule (4), following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-
  - "(5) All types of trailers and semitrailers covered under rule 125D, shall be registered independently.

Provided that, if the owner or registering party, requests to register the trailer or semitrailer jointly with compatible towing vehicle as a single vehicle, the registering authority shall register them as a single vehicle.

3. The principal rules were published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) vide notification number G.S.R 590E, dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 1989 and last amended vide notification number G.S.R 1461(E), dated the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2017.
