CIRCULAR

Sub: TD – RTO (HQ) – Strict Compliance of provisions of rule 62 & 104 of CMVA 1989 – Reg.

Ref: Notification No.G.S.R.807 (E), dt.23-10-2019 Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi.

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (Transport Division) has issued a notification with regard to amendment of Rule 62 and 104 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 vide reference cited as detailed below:

i. Maximum Speed:

The vehicle shall be driven in unladen conditions (with full charge and at full accelerator position) on straight or flat road and when the vehicle attains full speed, the maximum speed shall be calculated by measuring time taken to travel fixed distance, (say 50 metres).


ii. Reflectors:

Ensure colour of the reflectors and reflective tapes are as per rule 104.

2. Hence, it is hereby directed that the above amendment to the said rules are to be followed scrupulously while issue or renewal of the fitness certificate.
