NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with Notification No. 5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi and in supersession of the notification issued in General Administration Department's Notification No. TR. 49/65-CG, dated 28th February, 1966 published in supplement to the Gazette No. 21, of the 24th May 1966, the Lieutenant Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' (Technical) post of Motor Vehicles Inspector in the Transport Department, Pondicherry, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(i) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Transport Department, Group 'C' (Technical) Post of Motor Vehicles Inspector Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1984.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the schedule annexed hereto.

3. Methods of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said schedule.

4. Disqualifications.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Lieutenant Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings.—Nothing in these rules shall affect—

(i) the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard; and

(ii) the appointments and promotions already made in accordance with the rules hereby superseded.
